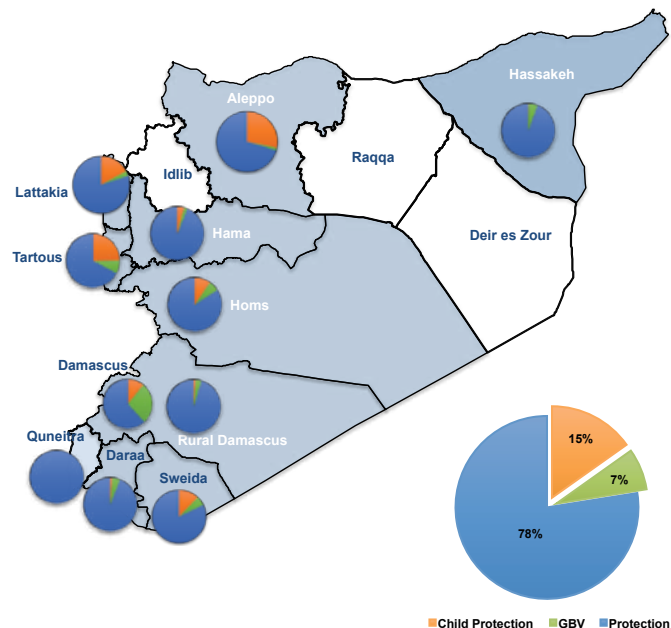
# WORKING WITH PARTNERS

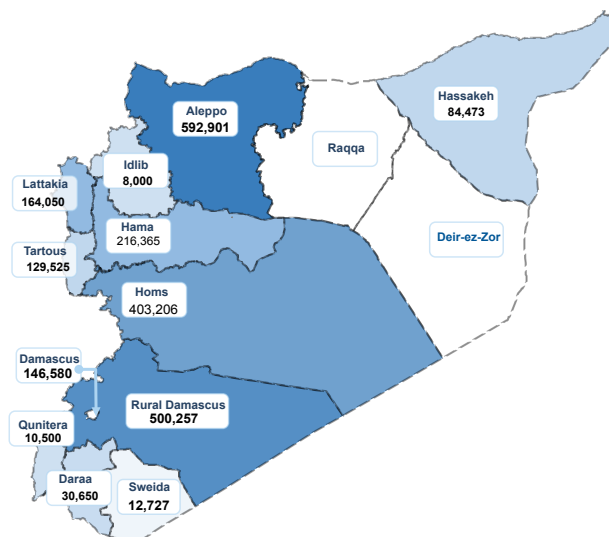

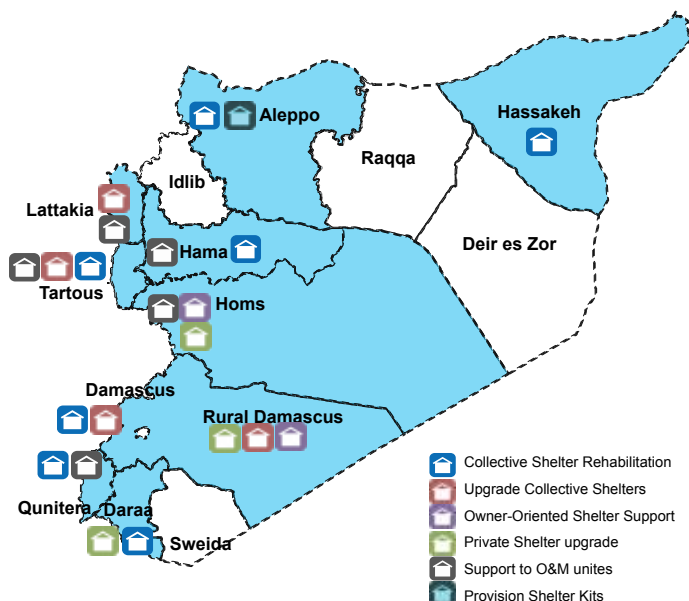
### Core Relief Items

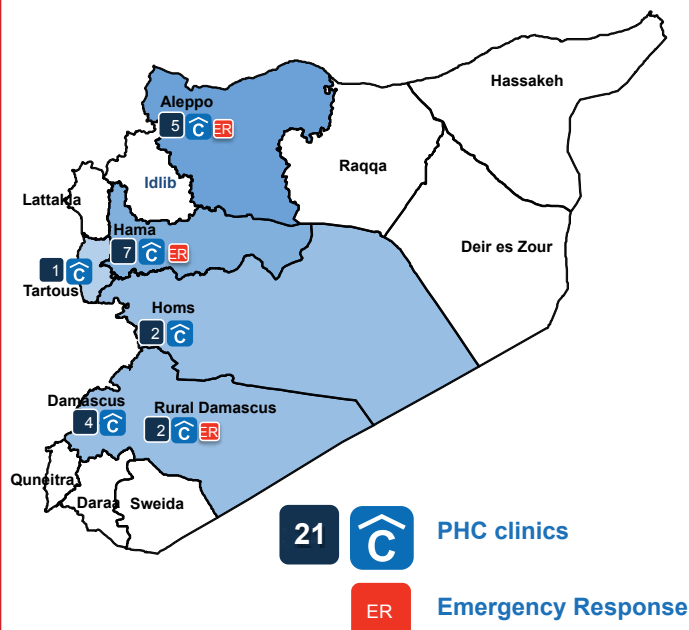
