

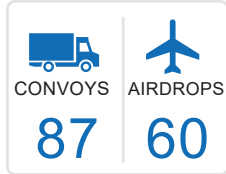
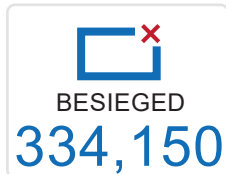
Syrian Arab Republic: 2016 UN Inter-Agency Humanitarian Operations (as of 22 June 2016)



Since the beginning of 2016, the UN and partners successfully delivered multi-sectoral assistance through inter-agency operations, reaching over 844,000 civilians in besieged, hard-to-reach and other priority cross-line locations with dire humanitarian needs. Many of these people were reached more than once. A total of 57 UN inter-agency convoys have been undertaken, reaching over 725,000 people. UNRWA has also delivered 30 convoys with multi-sectoral assistance to 19,000 in YBB*, including thousands of residents in and from Yarmouk. In addition, through 60 WFP-led airdrops, 976 metric tons of food supplies have been delivered to besieged parts of western Deir-ez Zor city. Current airdrops include materials that will be part of a second monthly food distribution due to begin once a critical mass of all commodities is received.

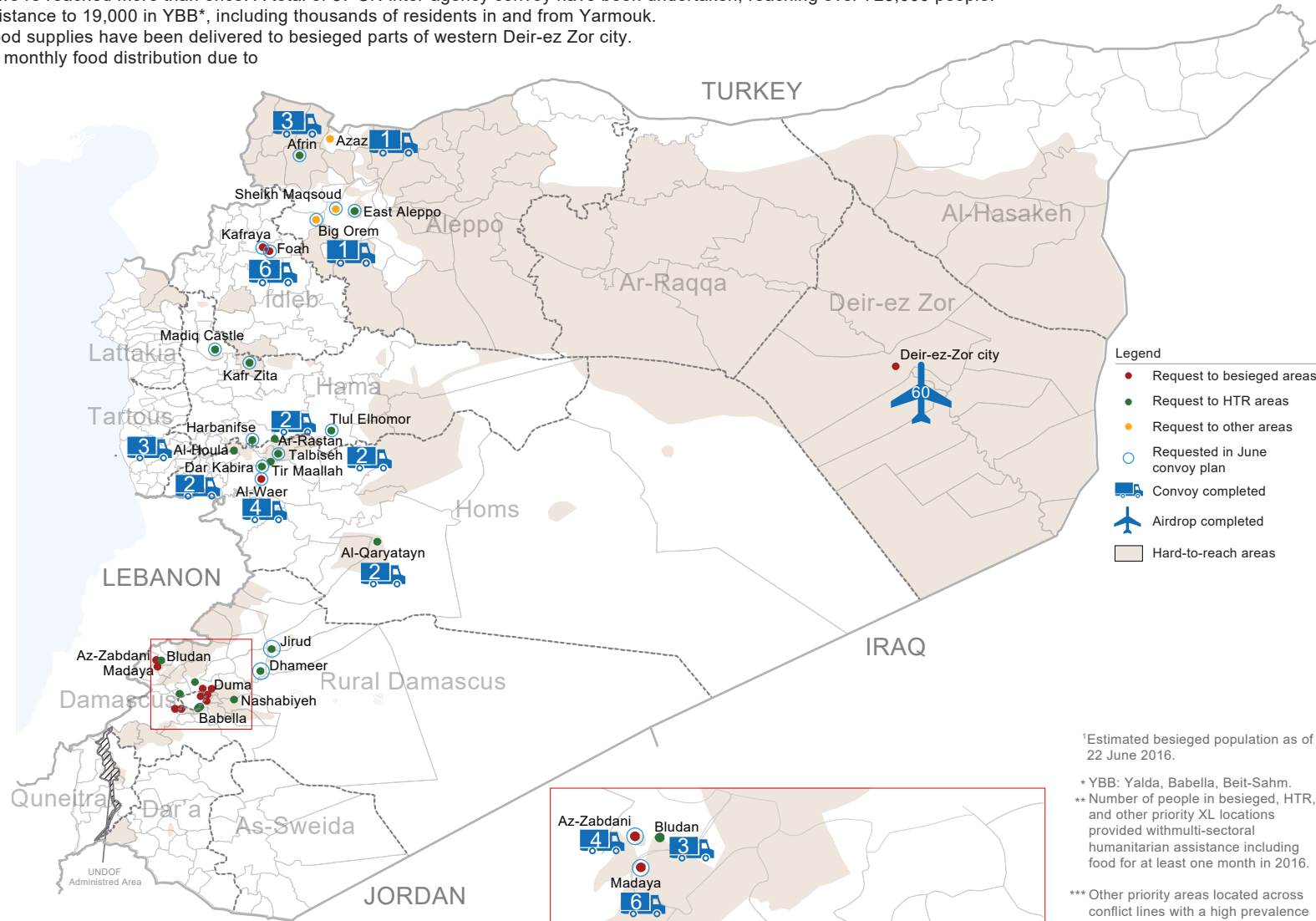

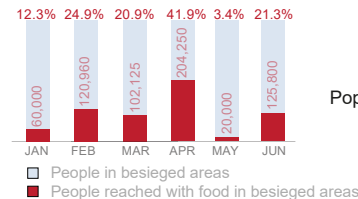

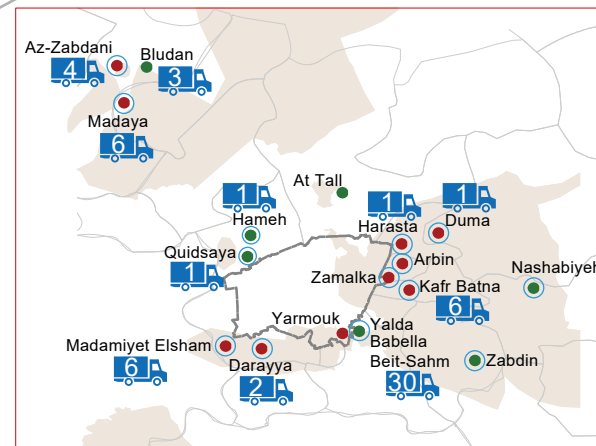
