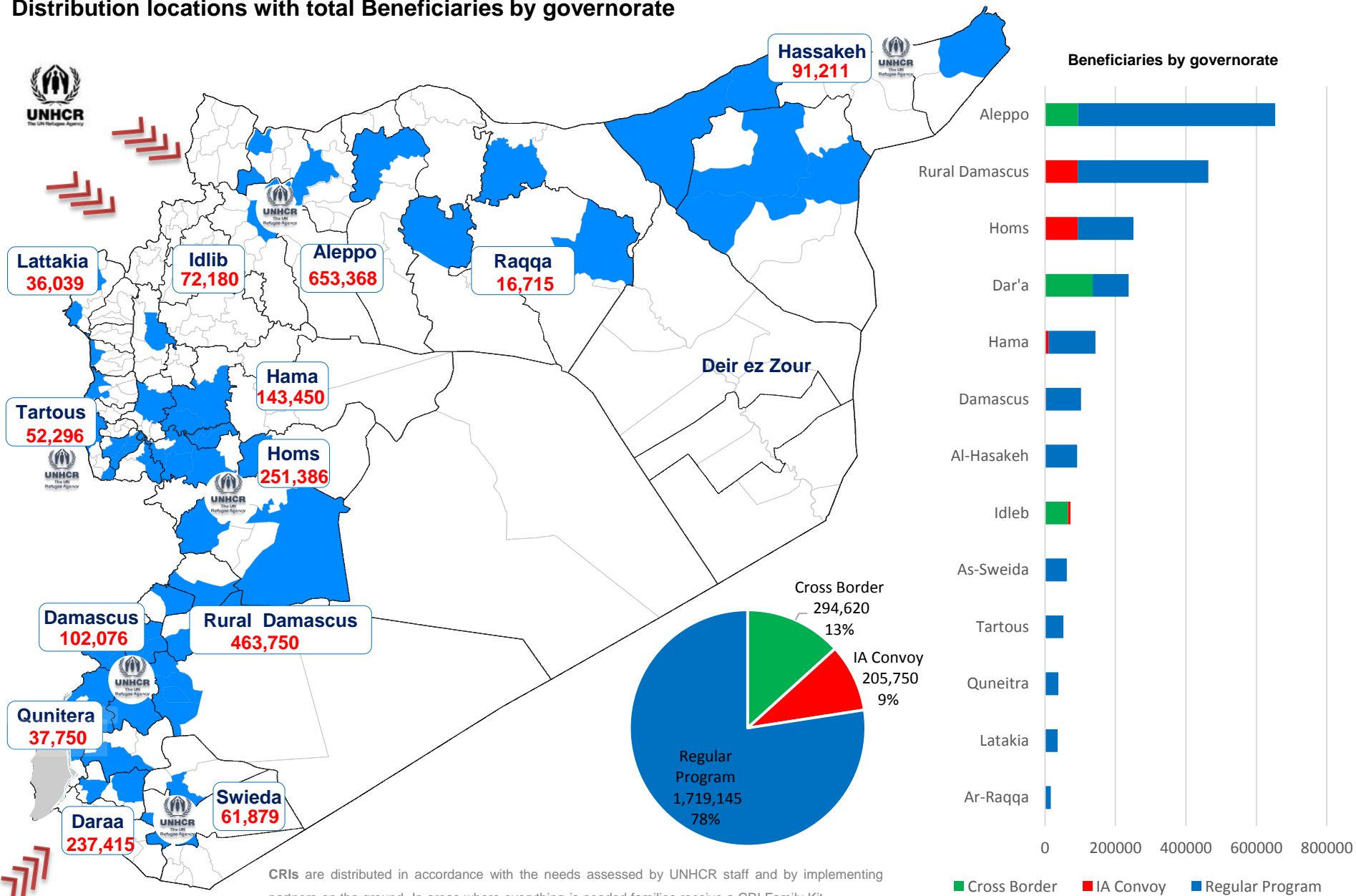

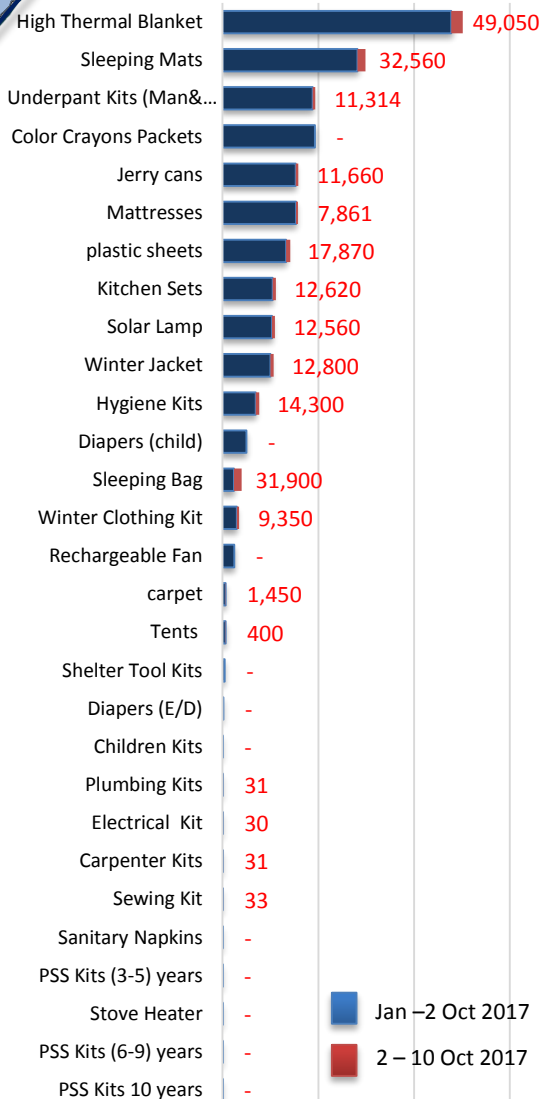
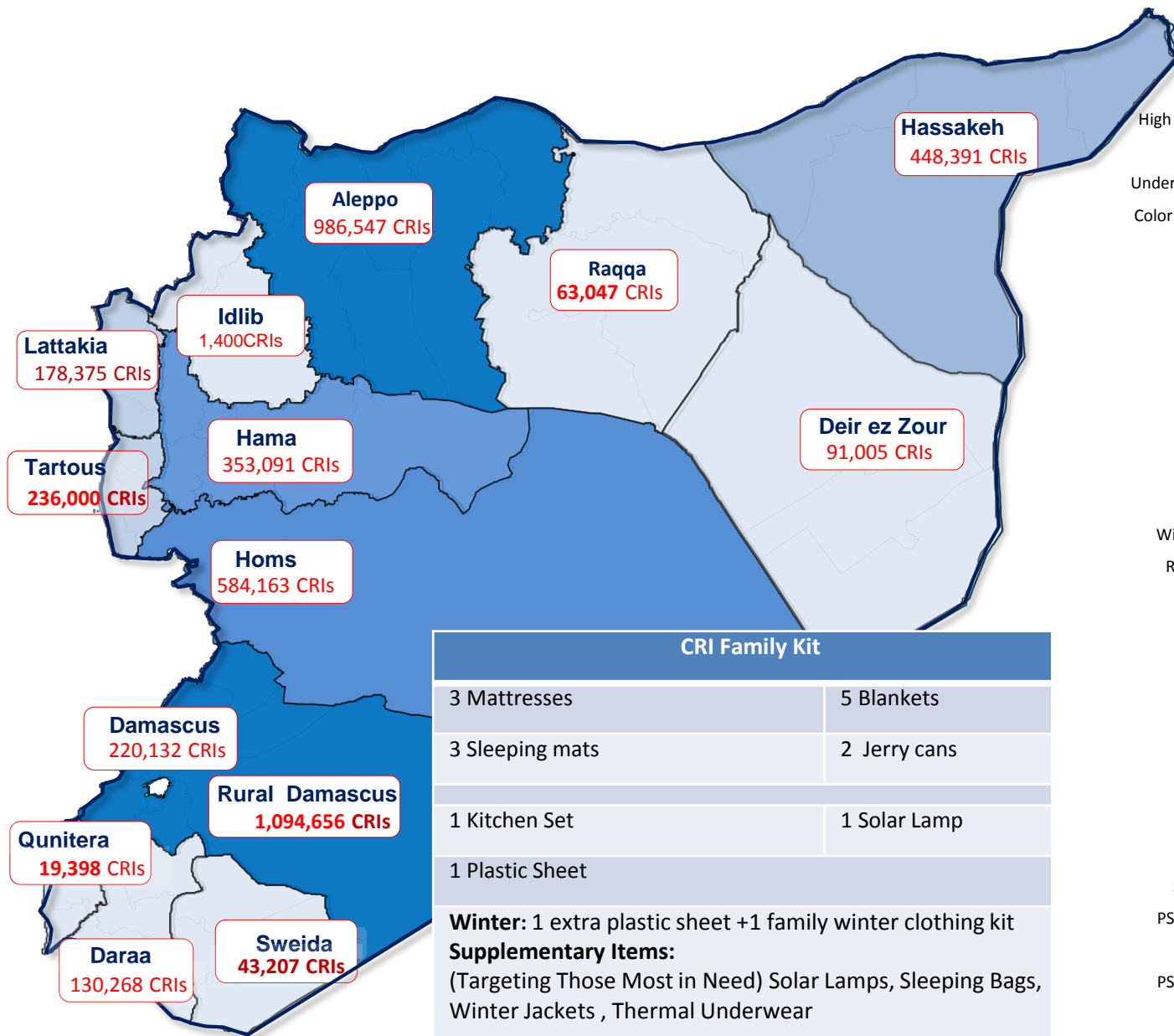
Distribution locations with total Beneficiaries by governorate



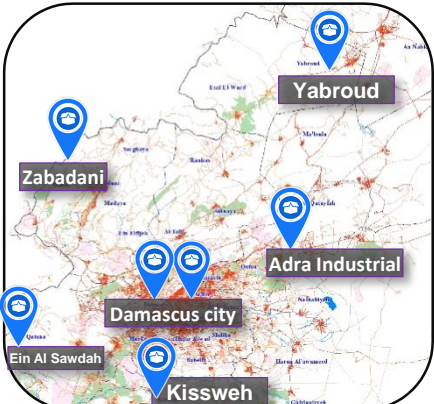
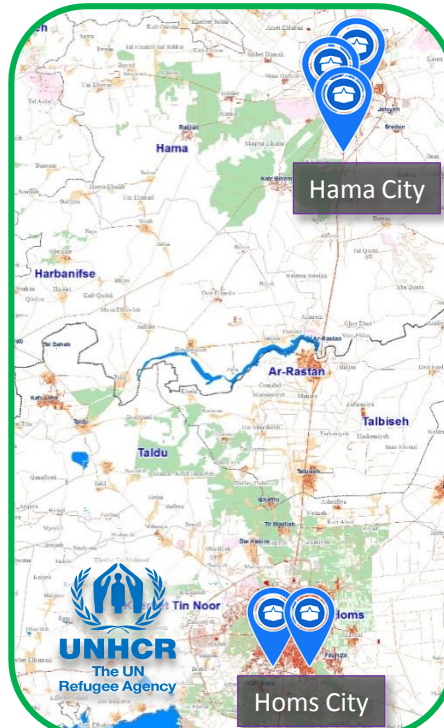
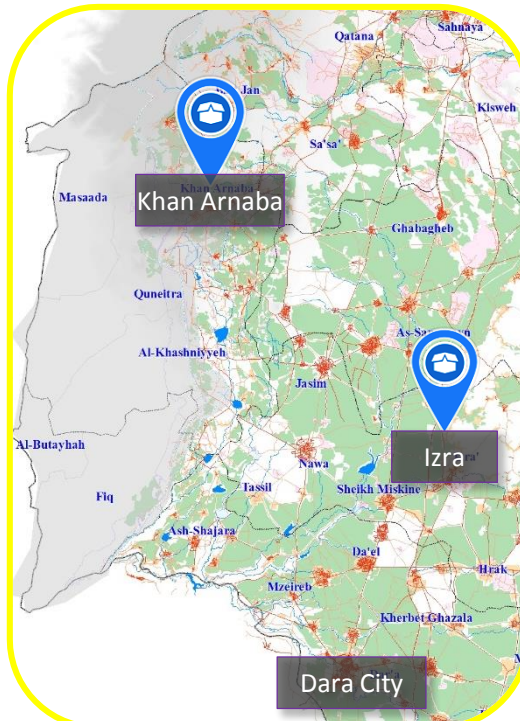
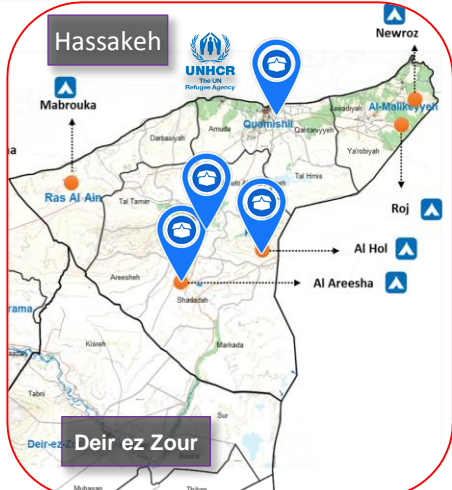
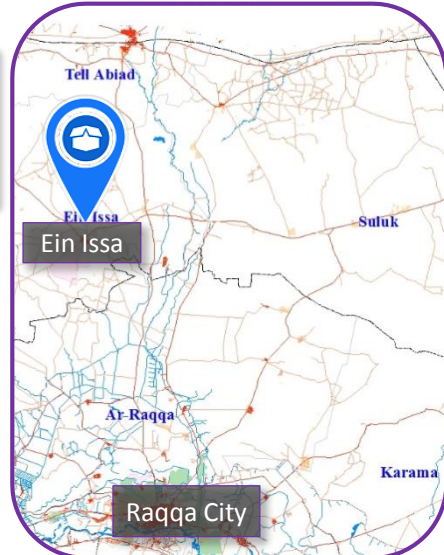
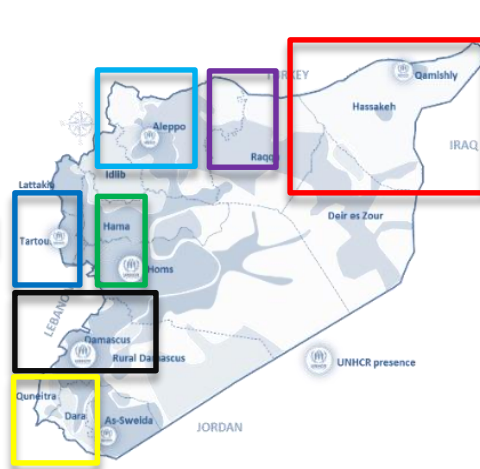

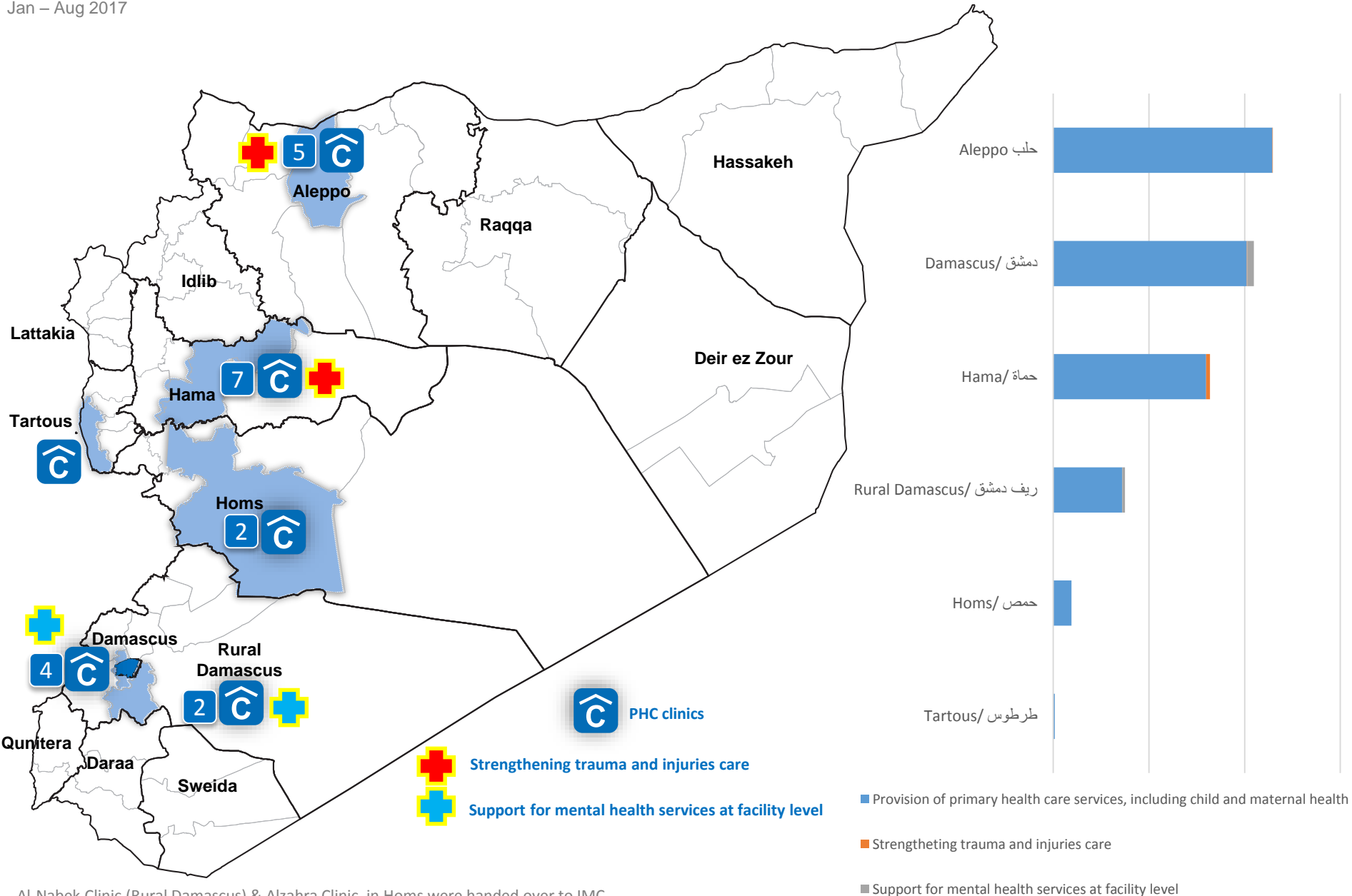
