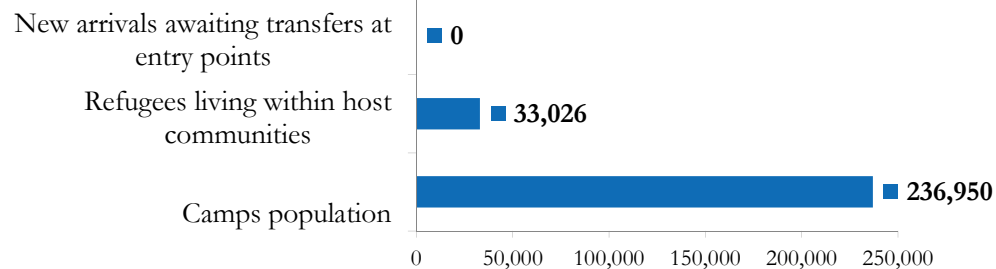


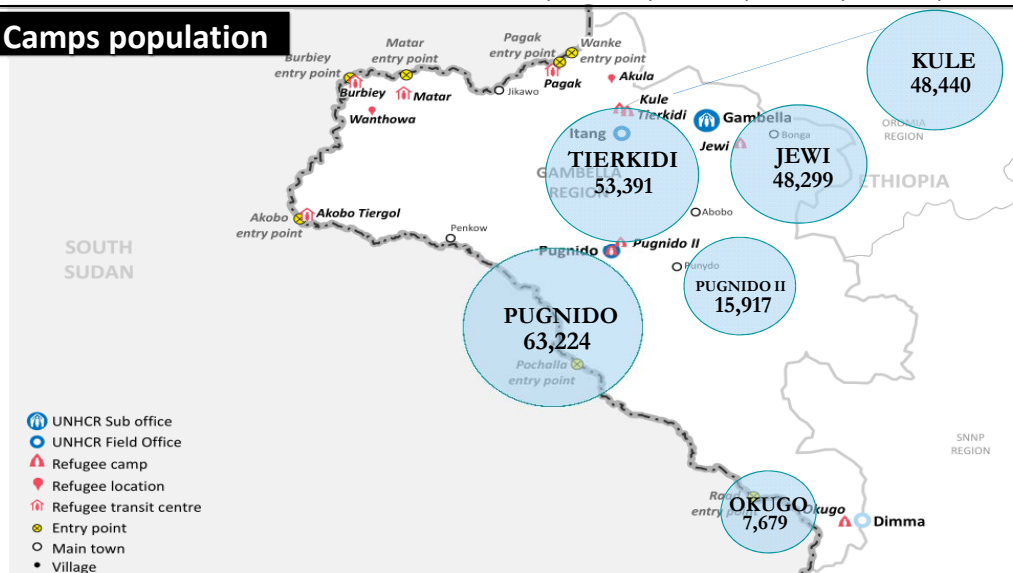
# South Sudanese refugee population in Gambella (as of 15-January-2016)

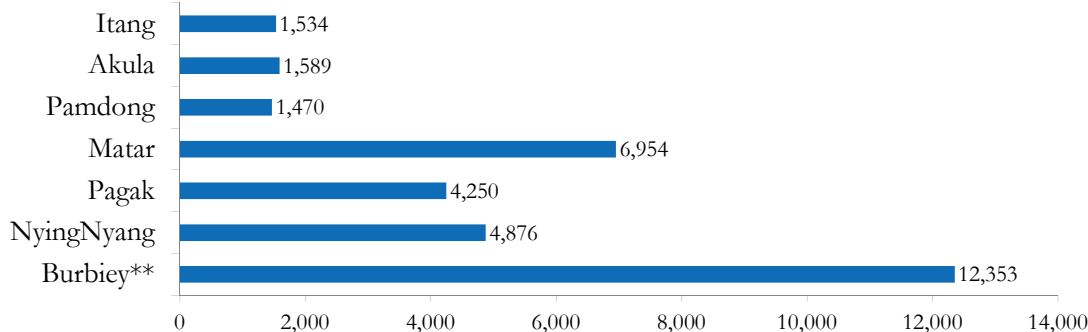

\* - In addition to 269,976 South Sudanese refugees in Gambella region, there are 11,174 refugees at the camps in Assosa [Breakdown: Pre 15th Dec 2013 = 6,129; Post 15th Dec 2013 = 5,045]. The total Gambella population includes 48,531 refugees who arrived pre 15-Dec-2013.

\*\* - Interviews with some refugees indicate that those with large livestock herds as well as traders and other categories were unwilling to move from border entry locations.
