

HUMANITARIAN ACCESS CONSTRAINTS



Proportion of humanitarian constraints on incidents involve humanitarian partners $\,$

The total number of reported access incidents increased to 112 reported cases in March (compared to 76 in February). The most prevalent incidents remained violence against personnel, assets and facilities with serious incidents of assault and threats of humanitarian staff due to increased criminality and banditry on road axis. Inter community conflicts and kidnapping of civilians persisted in regions including

Nana-Gribizi, Ouaka, Ouham and Ombella M'poko Provinces. Ongoing insecurity continued to impede humanitarian operations and the ability of humanitarian actors to reach affected populations.
