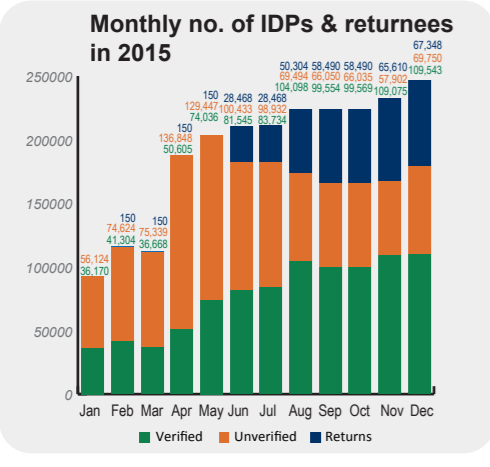

IDP figures constantly fluctuate. OCHA receives figures from different partners and triangulates them. The number of verified IDPs OCHA reports has been either verified by IOM or confirmed by inter-agency assessments / missions and / or during the provision of assistance by humanitarian partners. This in turn implies that the level of verification and accuracy varies greatly.
