July 2009 - Hundreds of refugees and IDPs from South Sudan, DR Congo and Central African Republic have fled attacks by the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA), a rebel group from Uganda. Since the start of July, more than 1,900 refugees have crossed into Western Equatoria from DR Congo and Central African Republic, many to Source Yubu and Ezo camps where attacks by the LRA were also reported on 18 Jul.
