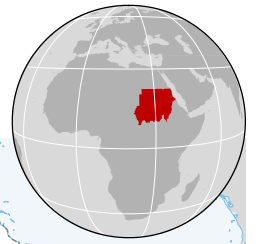


SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan

15 December 2013 - 24 September 2014

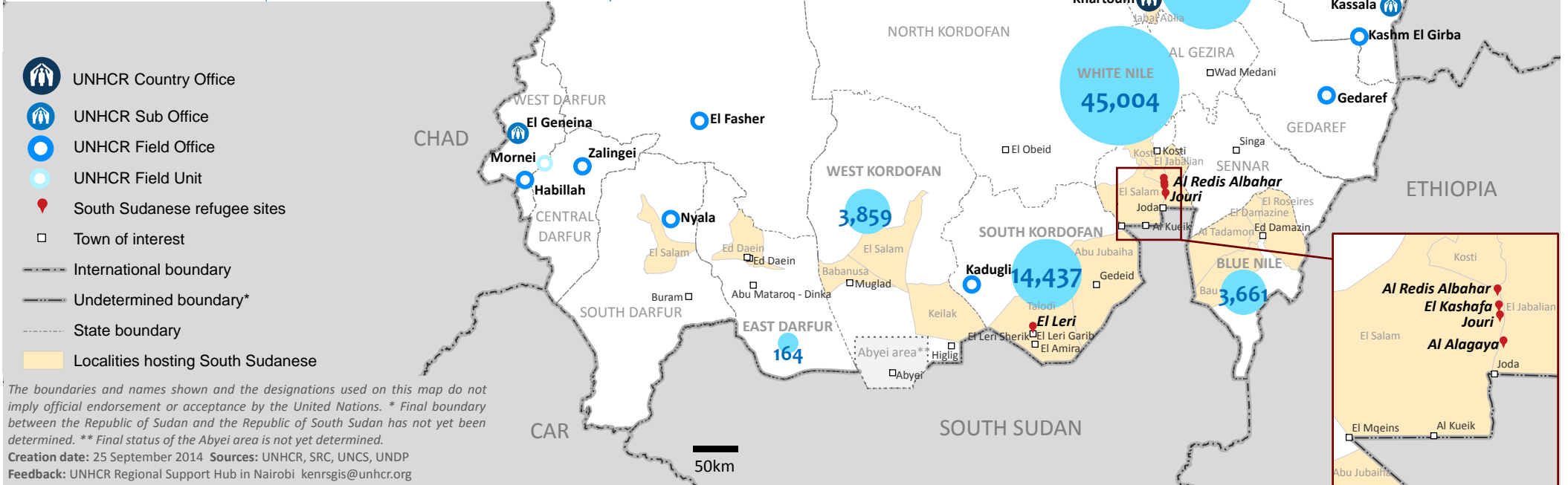


Over **96,603** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan
