













SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan | 1 – 15 August 2016

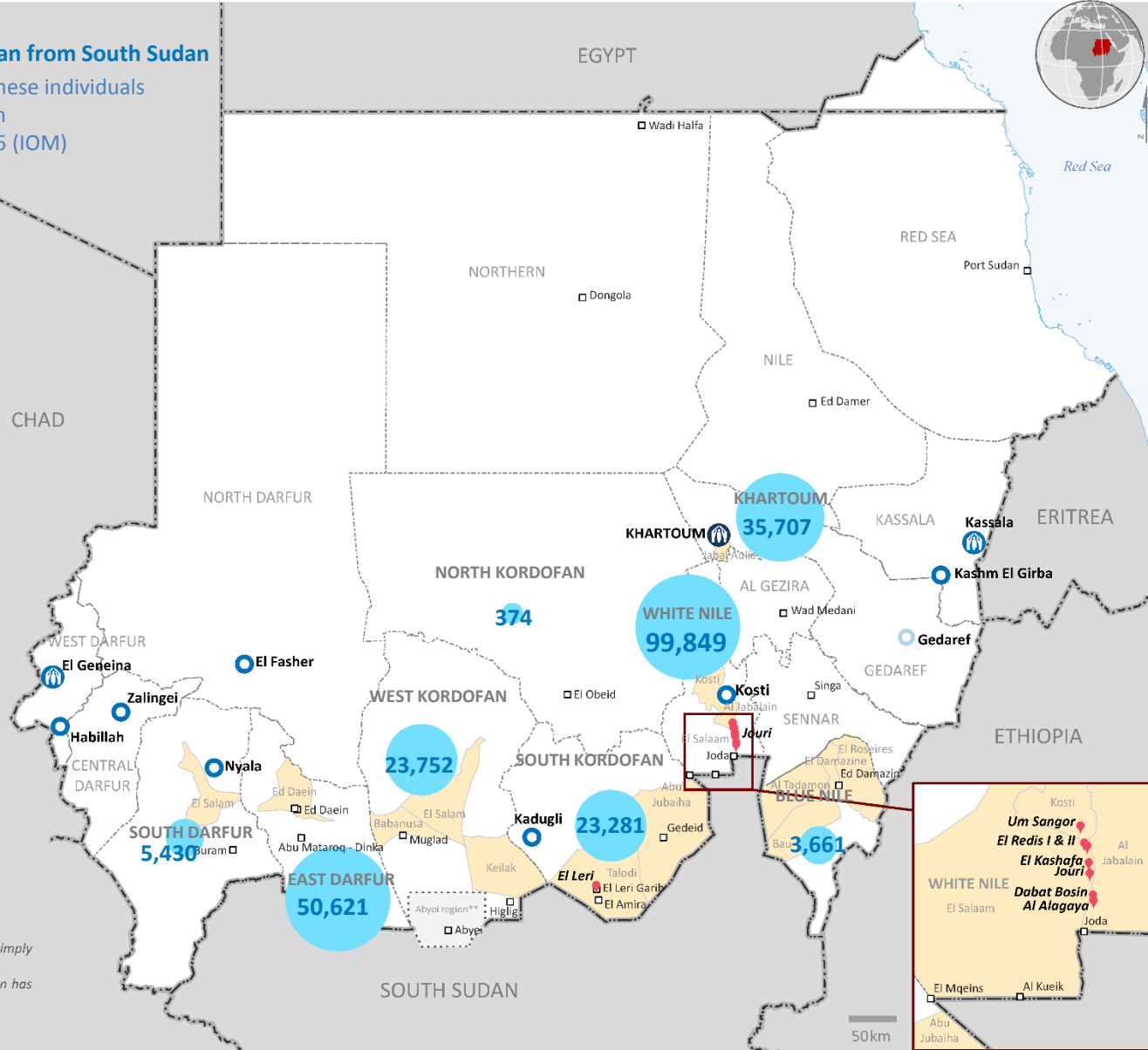
Over **242,675** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan
