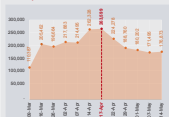

Assessments

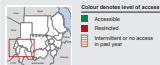
Assessments include rapid initial assessments, inter-agency assessments, as well as assessments conducted by single organizations and/or NGOs

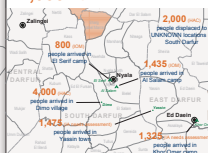
