## Arrivals from South Sudan | 1- 14 March 2016













Over **197,704** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan

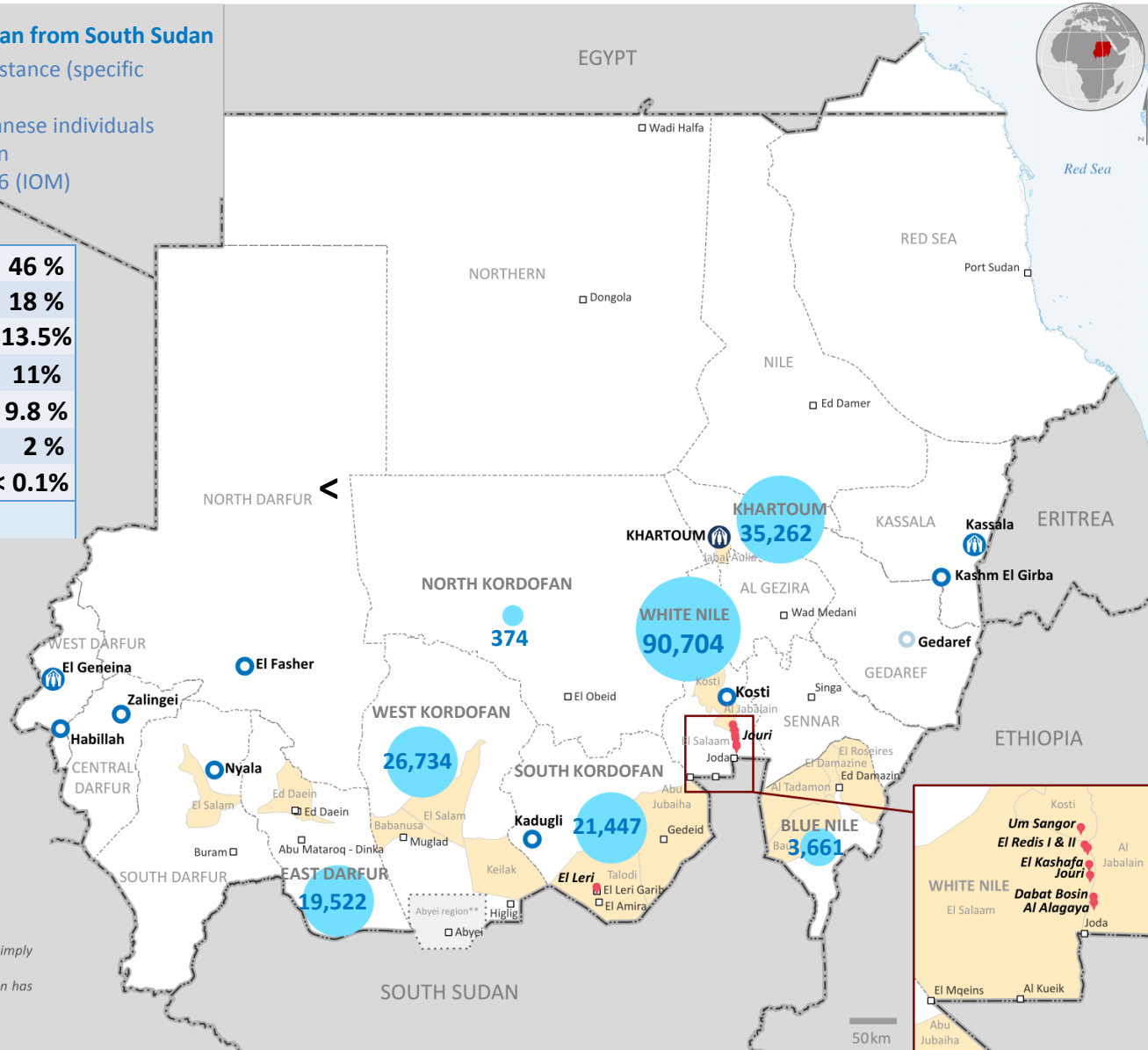
- 130,029 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only)
