













SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan | 29 April - 12 May 2016

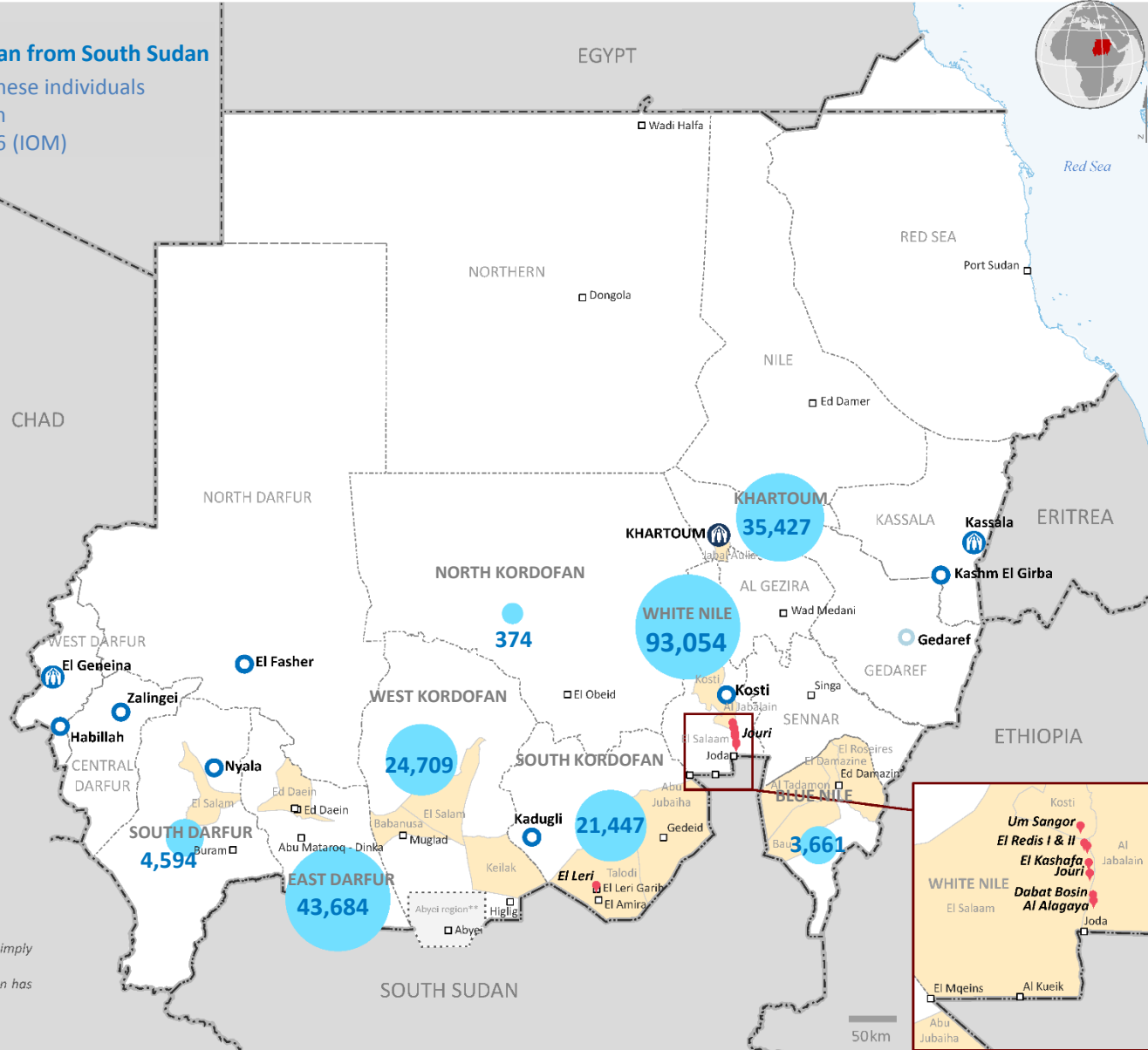
Over **226,950** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan
