## Ukraine: Humanitarian Snapshot (as of 26 May 2015)



Approximately 5 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance. Of these more than 1.3 million people are internally displaced. However many more remain unregistered because of changes and inconsistencies in the registration process. Social services are severely constrained and banking systems interrupted. This impacts on humanitarian situation in controlled non-government areas. Bureaucratic impediments continue to hamper humanitarian access.






