

7 May 2010 - Clashes between rebels in Sido and the Central African Republic (CAR) Army have caused an estimated 2,500 people to be displaced in the last few days. About 1,000 have reached a site for internally displaced persons in Kabo, some have crossed into Chad where more than 4,000 are seeking refuge in Moula refugee camp, and other are hiding in the bush. The ongoing offensive in the Sido area has been under way since mid-April.
