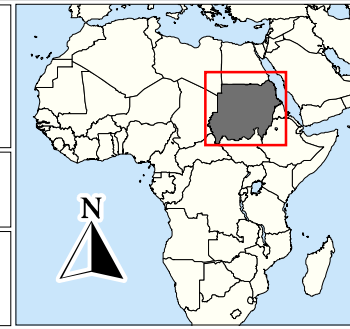

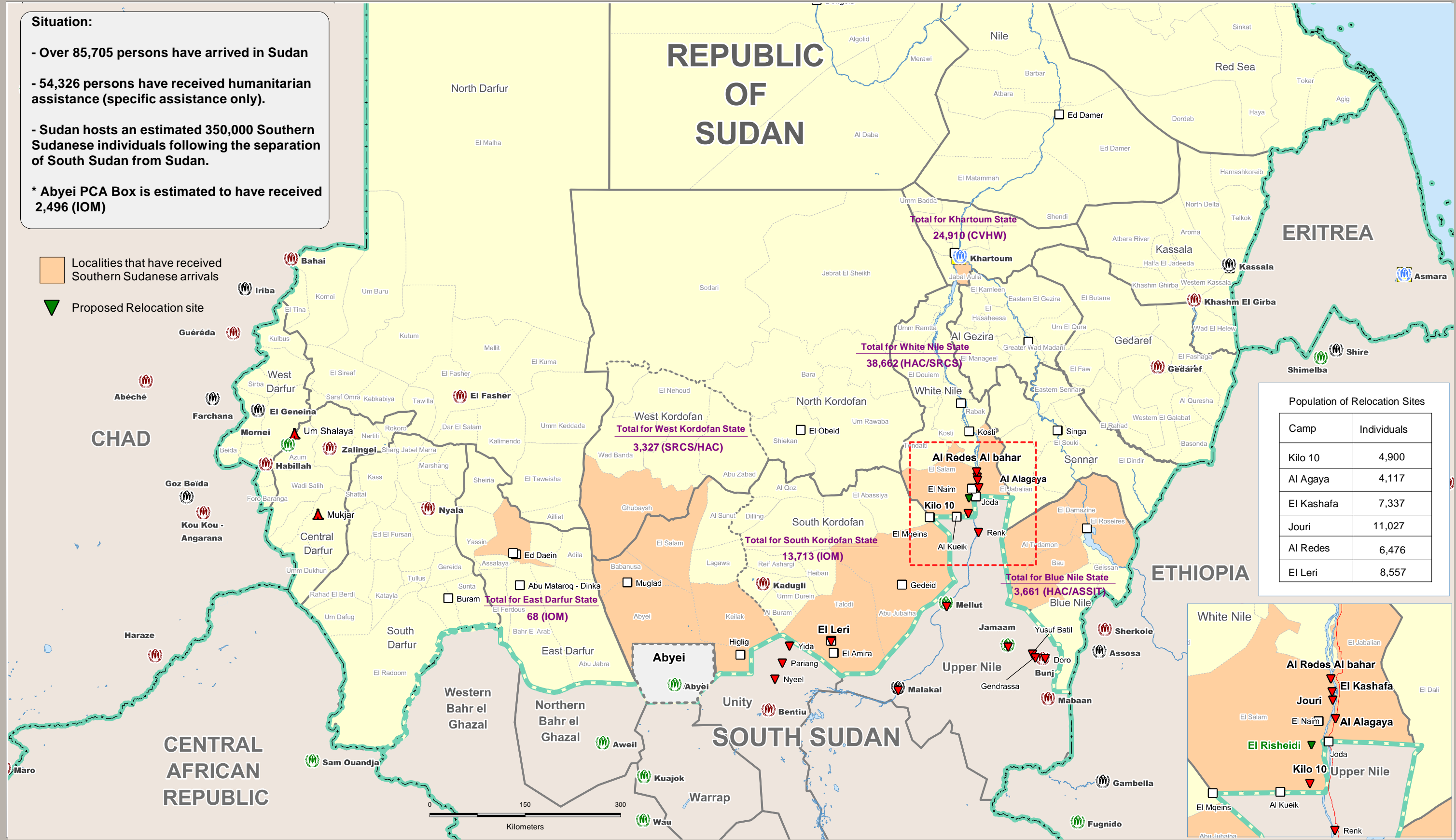

**Situation:**

- Over 85,705 persons have arrived in Sudan
- 54,326 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only).
- Sudan hosts an estimated 350,000 Southern Sudanese individuals following the separation of South Sudan from Sudan.
