

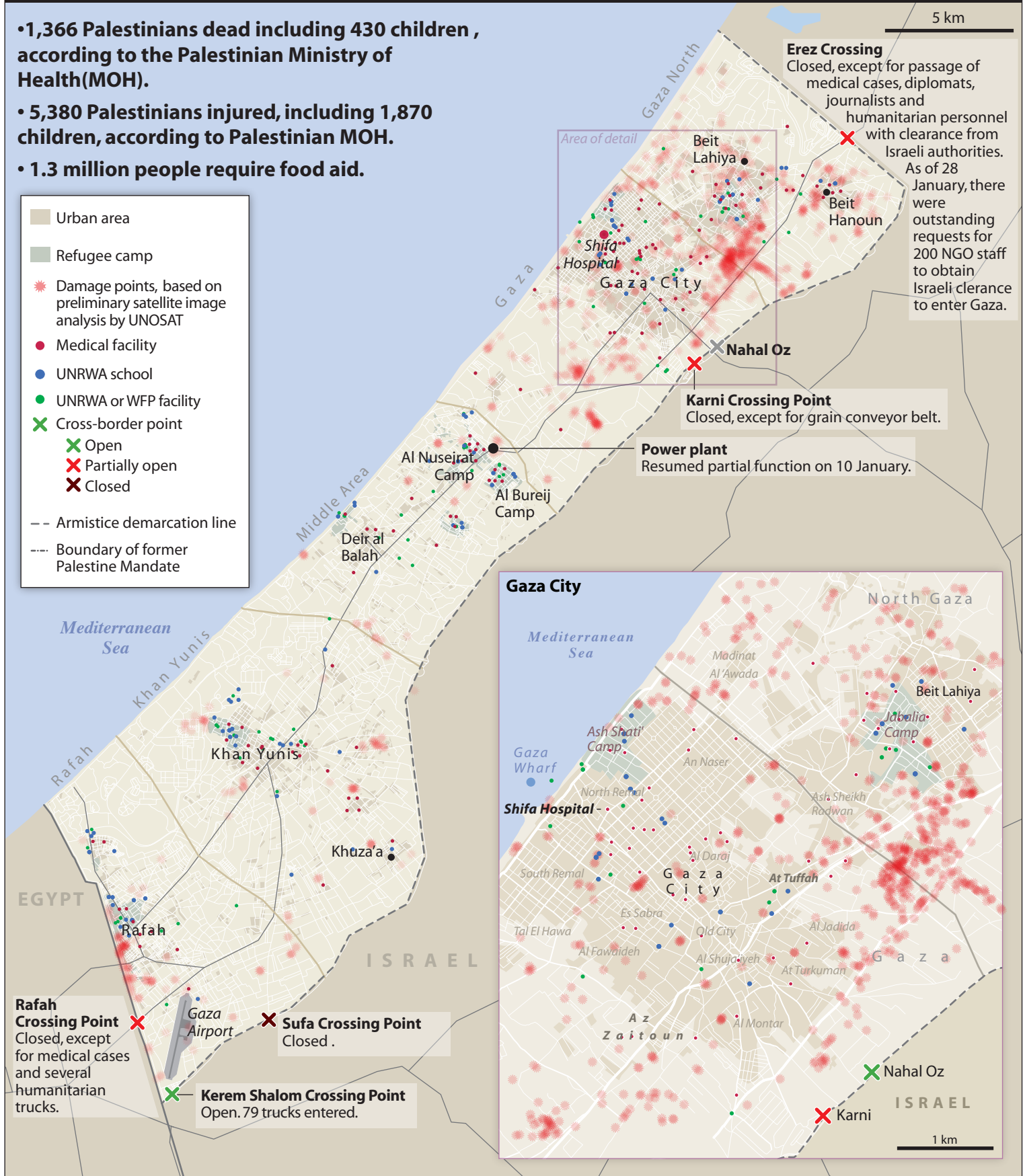
The Situation in The Gaza Strip (as of 29 Jan 2009)

• **1,366** Palestinians dead including **430** children , according to the **Palestinian Ministry of Health(MOH)**.

• **5,380** Palestinians injured, including **1,870** children, according to **Palestinian MOH**.

• **1.3 million** people require food aid.
