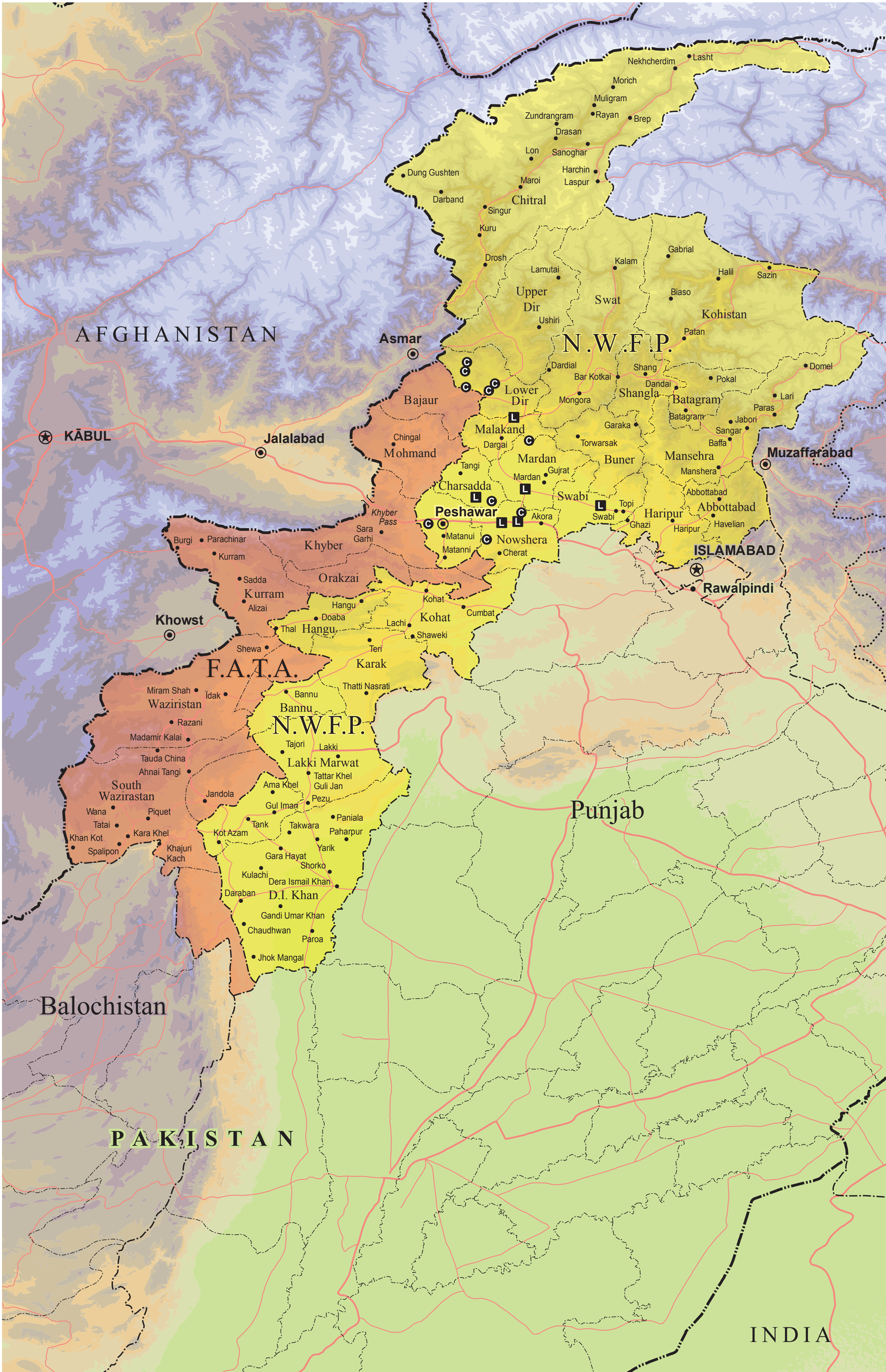


# PAKISTAN, N.W.F.P. - IDP camps
