5 Jun 2009 - People continue to flee conflict areas in Swat Valley to safer districts (Charsada, Mardan and Peshawar). 260,000 now in 21 camps in the North-West Frontier Province (NWFP). Camps in Mardan at full capacity, newly displaced directed to camps in Charsada, Peshawar and Swabi districts.
