RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

Report of the Sub-Commission on Promotion and Protection of Human Rights
on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action for the Prevention
of the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution and Child Pornography

Note by the Secretariat

1. In its resolution 1992/74, the Commission on Human Rights adopted the Programme of Action for the Prevention of the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution and Child Pornography. It also requested the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to submit every two years a report to the Commission on Human Rights on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action by all States.
2. In its resolution 1998/19, the Sub-Commission requested the Secretary-General to invite all States to inform the Working Group on Contemporary Forms of Slavery of measures adopted to implement the Programme of Action.
3. The Sub-Commission also requested the Secretary-General to submit a report on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action to the Sub-Commission at its fiftieth-first session and to the Commission at its fifty-sixth session. Pursuant to that request, the attention of the Commission is drawn to the report of the Secretary-General to the Sub-Commission on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action (E/CN.4/Sub.2/1999/15 and Add.1), which is being made available to the Commission at its present session.
