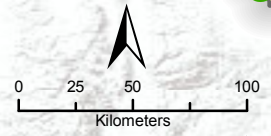


This map reflects the number of people reached with life saving activities against the 2016 Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) for Syrian Arab Republic as part of Strategic Objective 1.

Sector Objective 1 (SO1) : Provide emergency response capacity, lifesaving, and life sustaining assistance to the most vulnerable crisis affected people, including people with specific needs.
