

This map shows both the locations that IDPs fled from (in green) and locations that IDPs went to, in and around Mogadishu (red dots).

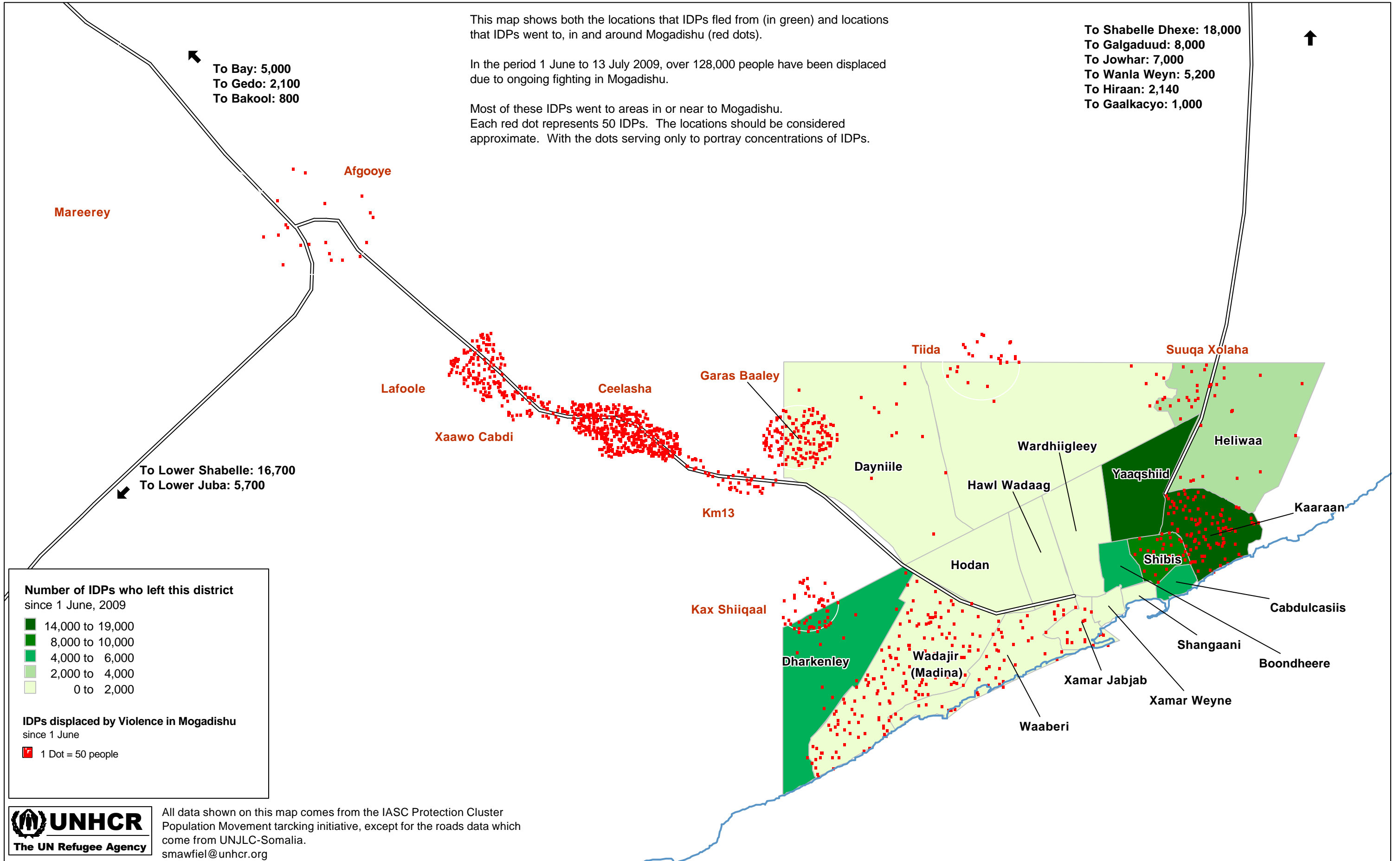
In the period 1 June to 13 July 2009, over 128,000 people have been displaced due to ongoing fighting in Mogadishu.

Most of these IDPs went to areas in or near to Mogadishu. Each red dot represents 50 IDPs. The locations should be considered approximate. With the dots serving only to portray concentrations of IDPs.
