Resolution 1913 (2010)**Adopted by the Security Council at its 6283rd meeting, on
12 March 2010***The Security Council,**Recalling* its resolutions and the statements of its President concerning Chad, the Central African Republic and the subregion, including resolution 1769 (2007), 1778 (2007), 1834 (2008) and resolution 1861 (2009),*Considering* the note verbale of the government of Chad of 19 January 2010, its letter of 3 March 2010 (S/2010/115), and the letter of the Secretary-General of 11 March 2010, indicating that discussions on the future of the United Nations Mission in the Central African Republic and Chad (MINURCAT) are still ongoing,*Determining* that the situation in the region continues to constitute a threat to international peace and security,

1. *Decides* to extend until 15 May 2010 the mandate of MINURCAT as set out in resolution 1861 (2009);
 2. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
