

SUDAN: 2016 New Displacements and Affected People in Darfur as of 31 July 2016

Notes:

In Sortony and Tawilla, authorities halted IOM registration and verification processes in mid-February. As a result, figures underwent revision and have now been amended according to WFP's latest beneficiary figure in July.

In Boori and Wadi Boori, confirmation of reported displacement in the area and / or to other areas is still not possible due to lack of humanitarian access.

HAC reported 40,000 new returnees in Golo in June. No confirmation of this figure by humanitarian partners has yet been possible. Similarly, HAC-reported returns from Sortony (2,060 people) and Tawilla (3,000 people) to Fanga Suk village and Rokero town are yet to be confirmed.
