The IOM figure for Tawilla is currently under revision due to IOM's halt of registration and verification processes since mid-February. Cross-checking against humanitarian assistance figures provided so far is currently ongoing and, as such, a final, revised, figure is not yet available.

The number of verified IDPs OCHA reports on has been either registered / verified by IOM or confirmed through inter-agency assessments / missions and / or during the provision of assistance by IASC humanitarian partners. This, in turn, implies that the level of verification and accuracy varies greatly.
