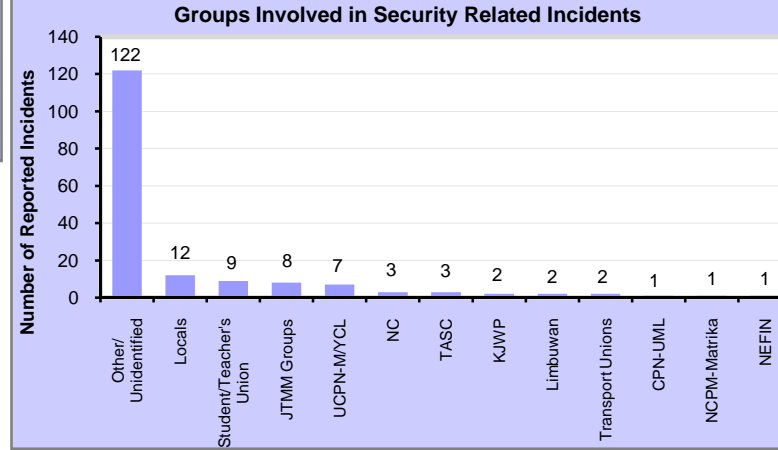

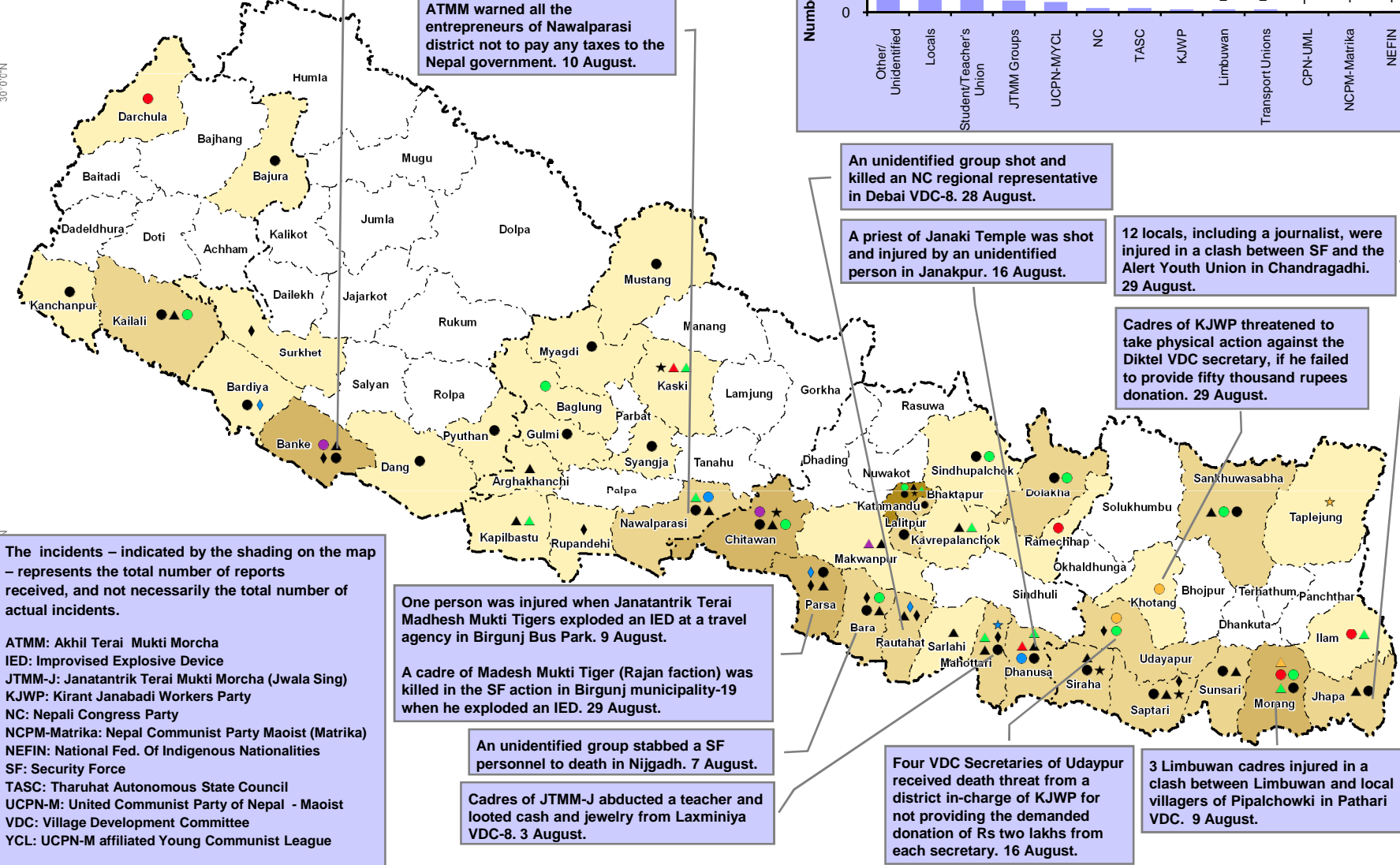

One person was injured when Janatantrik Terai Madhesh Mukti Tigers exploded an IED at a travel agency in Birgunj Bus Park. 9 August.

A cadre of Madesh Mukti Tiger (Rajan faction) was killed in the SF action in Birgunj municipality-19 when he exploded an IED. 29 August.

An unidentified group stabbed a SF personnel to death in Nijgadh. 7 August.

Cadres of JTMM-J abducted a teacher and looted cash and jewelry from Laxminiya VDC-8. 3 August.

An unidentified group shot and killed an NC regional representative in Debai VDC-8. 28 August.

A priest of Janaki Temple was shot and injured by an unidentified person in Janakpur. 16 August.

12 locals, including a journalist, were injured in a clash between SF and the Alert Youth Union in Chandragadhi. 29 August.

Cadres of KJWP threatened to take physical action against the Diktel VDC secretary, if he failed to provide fifty thousand rupees donation. 29 August.

Four VDC Secretaries of Udaypur received death threat from a district in-charge of KJWP for not providing the demanded donation of Rs two lakhs from each secretary. 16 August.

3 Limbuwan cadres injured in a clash between Limbuwan and local villagers of Pipalchowki in Pathari VDC. 9 August.
