#### (d) Alleged terrorist group dismantled in Santa Cruz

62. On 16 April 2008, an alleged terrorist group was dismantled in the city of Santa Cruz in a police operation in which three foreign nationals were killed. Currently, 39 people have been charged: 22 are facing trial (6 are in detention) and 17 were declared to be fugitives. The case was relocated from Tarija back to Santa Cruz owing to the health problems of one of the accused. The trial is at the stage of the reception of oral declarations of defendants.
