

3. Observations on the communications sent and received in the reporting period are reflected in an addendum to the present report (A/HRC/20/22/Add.4). During the period under review, the Special Rapporteur sent 113 communications to 52 countries (including 64 urgent appeals and 49 allegation letters). The main issues covered in the communications were attacks or killings (44), the death penalty (21), excessive use of force (19), death threats (14), deaths in custody (5), impunity (5), armed conflict (3), and expulsion (2). The status of individuals who were the subject of concern with regard to requests for stays of execution is contained in an annex to A/HRC/20/22/Add.4.
